Greetings Officers and Members,

The Board of Directors is proactive in keeping the members abreast of the information needed for the 104th National Convention. We thank all delegates who followed our request and made your hotel reservations early. This has helped us prepare for our 104th National Convention in Washington, DC.

The Board will meet at the host hotel in Washington, DC, for the Mid-Winter Meeting on February 17–18, 2023. Based on the current lodging rooms picked up for the National Convention, the Board is anticipating reducing the Room Block by at least two hundred (200) room nights for the convention. Therefore, we encourage you to reserve your room as soon as possible to ensure that you have a room at the convention rate.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS FUNDRAISER: Please support the Board of Directors Fundraiser project to help raise funds for the organization. See the attached NUCUAA Order Form. The deadline to place orders is **March 1, 2023**, for delivery at Regional Conferences.

Hotel Parking: Parking at the host hotel for the 104th National Convention is \$62.00 per day. The discounted rate is 15% (discount of \$9.30). The total parking rate per day is \$52.70. The Board is trying to obtain discount parking at "Union Station" for the Delegates. Additional information will be provided at a later date.

Preferred Airport: The preferred airport to fly into and out of for the 104th National Convention is the Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport in Arlington County, Virginia. The airport is about 5.8 miles from the hotel.

Shuttle Service from and to the Airport: The host hotel does not provide a shuttle service from the Airport to the hotel or from the hotel to the Airport.

Amtrak Train: The destination in Washington, DC, is "Union Station." Union Station is about a half mile from the host hotel.

Uber or Lyft Options: Transportation options using the Uber or Lyft application on mobile phones from and to the Airport and Union Station are available. The cost will vary depending on the time of day.

SOUTHWEST AIRLINES: Southwest Airlines is proud to partner with NUCUAA. Attendees of the 104th NUCUAA Convention can take advantage of discounted fares traveling to/from Washington, DC. Attendees will receive a 3% discount and a 25% bonus Rapid Reward points by booking via **SWABIZ** with Company ID ***99626310**. Delegates can start booking flights on December 15, 2022. Reservations are accepted through July 10, 2023.

Background Checks: Supervisors attending the Junior and Young People's Department meetings and outings will need a current background check before the National Convention. Vendor Opportunities: Vending opportunities at the 104th National Convention will be limited. The fee is \$500.00 per exhibit space or \$900.00 for two (2) spaces. A signed agreement and a non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 per space or \$400.00 for two (2) spaces are required to reserve a space(s). The balance of \$300.00 for one (1) space or \$500.00 for two (2) spaces is due by **June 1, 2023**. Payments must be in the form of a money order, bank check, or credit card.
